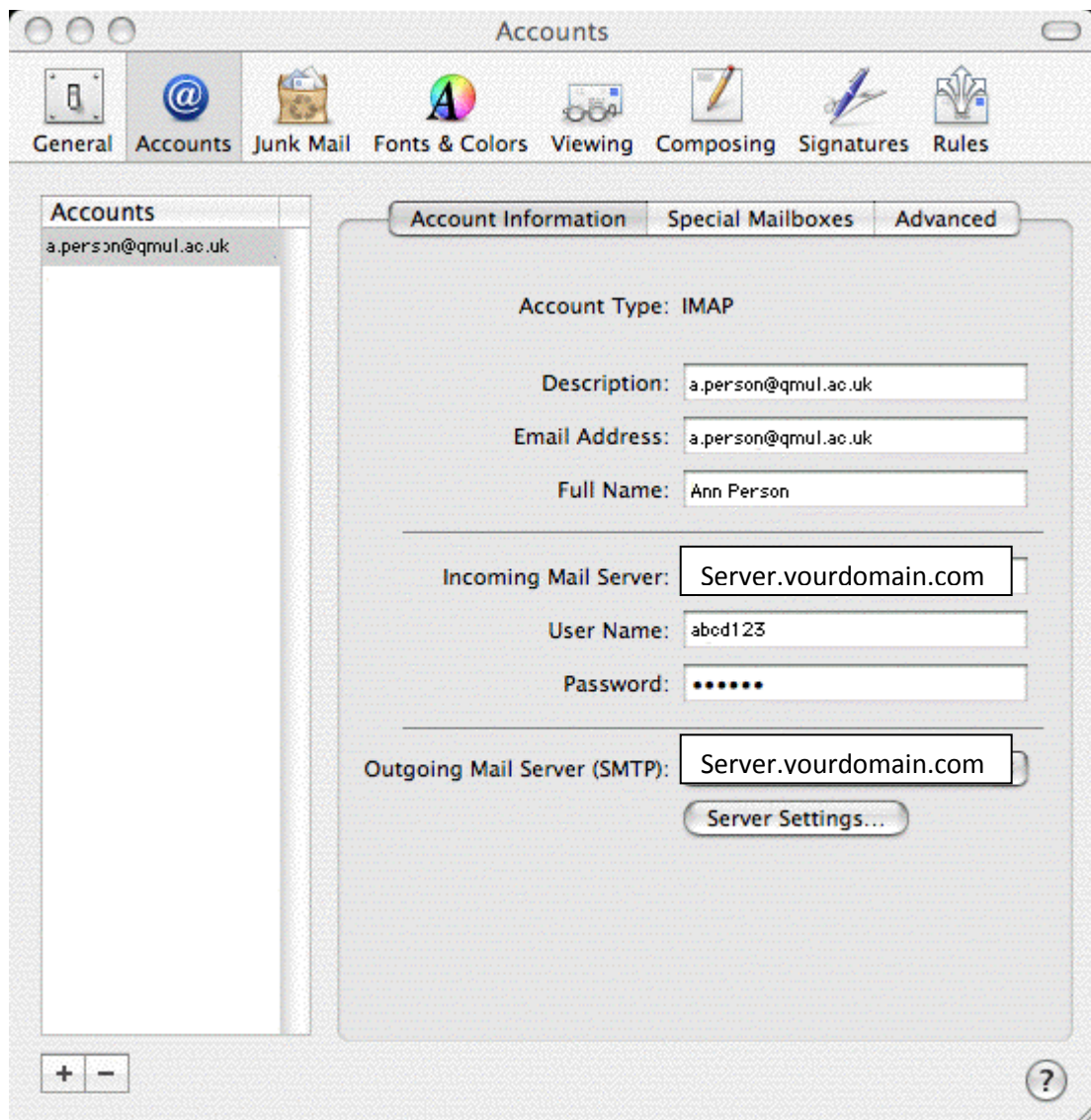

Changing Authentication Settings

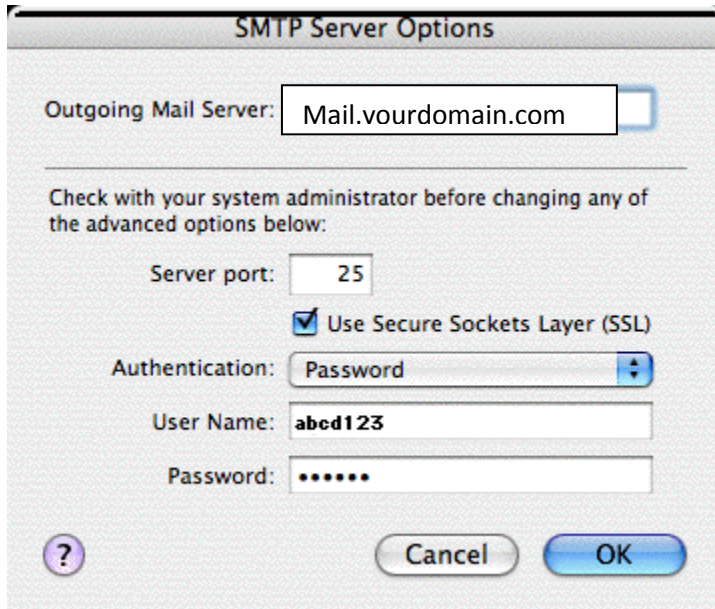
Apple Mail 1.3.9 on Mac Os X 10.3.8

- Go to **Mail > Preferences** and highlight the account
- Select the *Account Information* tab:



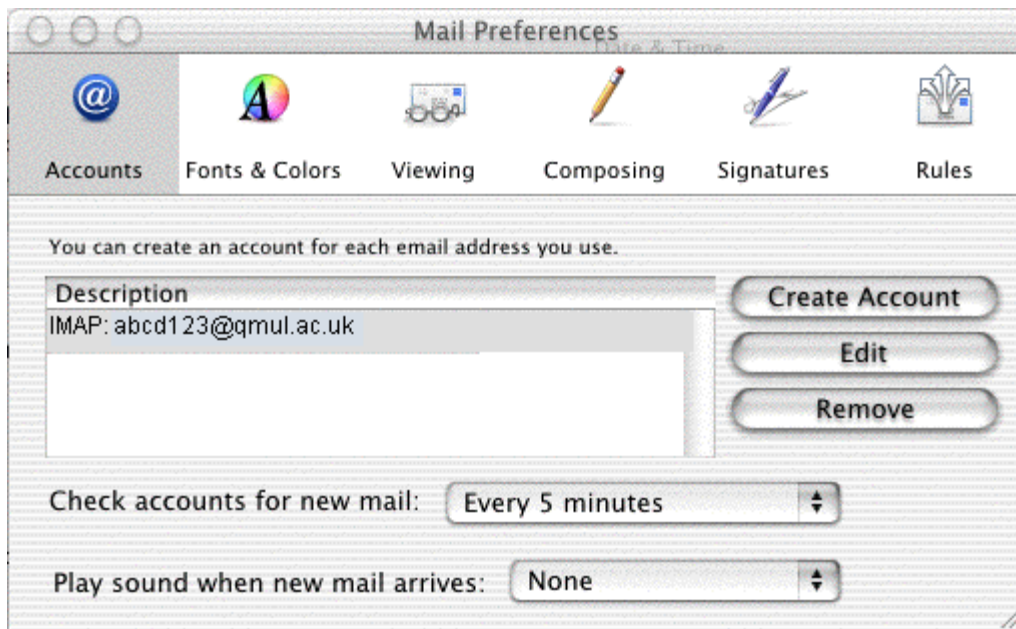
- In the *Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP)* section, click on **Server Settings**.
- Select **Password** as the *Authentication method*.

- Enter your MAIL username and password:



Earlier Apple Mail versions on Mac Os X 10.2.

- Go to **Application > Preferences** and click the **Accounts** option:



- Select the relevant account and click on **Edit**
- Tick *Use authentication when sending mail*
- Enter SMTP User name and password:
